#### 3.1 Statement

## 4.1 Rent increase.

A complaint has been lodged with the relevant Department by phone regarding the rent increase, although the promised follow up call has not been received. The Committee agreed to send a letter of complaint that had been drafted, to the complaints Department requesting a written response within seven days (to be sent by recorded delivery). #### 4.2 Usher's Field Gates

Agreed – not to install lock to outer gates.

## 4.3 Fires complaint

There has been no further communication from the Council.

The Committee should reiterate member responsibilities when burning, and the sensitivities. This will also be raised at the AGM. (Action: All; I. Hornsey)

## 4.4 Thefts

No new burglaries have been reported. The Committee should remain vigilant and also make plot-holders aware that this has happened. Plot-holders should report burglaries to the Committee (but can also report them to the Police). Anyone caught stealing produce etc. will face immediate eviction. Plot-holders should be discouraged from entering any other gardens without express permission of the tenant. (Action: Committee)

## 4.5 Fence replacement at Waterworks site

Estimates have been received for the work and contractor agreed. Awaiting start date. (Action: I. Hornsey)

#### 4.6 Rabbits

In progress – contacting the Council to ask them to contact nearby landowners (including Network Rail) to identify whether any action is being taken to control rabbit infestations on neighbouring land. (Action : I. Hornsey)

## 4.7 Water

This has been turned on again.

#### 4.8 Trees at Shields Road

The Council has confirmed it will manage the trees overhanging the site at Shields Road. Awaiting date.

## 4.9 Request for plot from Community Group

Committee agreed that the Fulwell Community Library/Friends of Fulwell should be added to the waiting list for a Community garden.

## 4.10 Removing asbestos

It was confirmed that the Committee will remove the waste but that the plot-holder should bag it and leave it for collection.

## 4.11 Letters

The Committee agreed that two drafted letters should now be sent to the relevant plot-holders.

## 4.12 AGM

No decision was made at this stage until a response has been received from the Council regarding the rent increase.
